

NORTHWEST REGION SCCA
RACE COMMITTEE MEETING
April 23, 2007

Race Committee meeting was held at Andy's Diner, Seattle, WA. Attendees were: Tom Masterson (Asst. RE-Race), Jay Bratton (Race Treasurer), Joan Manley (Race Secretary), Mike & Lynn Evans, Bob Grass, Ken Jones, David & Rachel Joehnke, Val Korry, Frank Manley, Sherri Masterson and Bob Rygg. Meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m.

1. Minutes of March 26, 2007 were approved, M/S Jay Bratton/Sherri Masterson, with following correction: Item 3. Annual Tech – Scrutineers were Mike Lawler, Dan Carchano & Mike Currie (from Canada).
2. Treasurer's report was approved as presented by Jay Bratton. Copy is attached to secretary's file. Items discussed were expenditures and entries for both the April 28-29 Double Regional races and the May 26-28 Double National races.
3. Chiefs' reports:
 - Flagging – Mike Evans reported that canopies will be repaired and at BMP. New canopies will be purchased when on sale.
 - Sound – GT Thunder entrants at the Double National want sound readings on Friday at Tune & Test. This day is the responsibility of Pacific Raceways.
 - Registration – Bremerton event has 39 entrants. Staff will include Linda Hallberg, Kelly McCloskey and Karen McCoy.
 - Timing & Scoring – staff now working on equipment.
 - Sweeper – Ken Jones reported he will locate one for use at BMP. Sherri Masterson said that it should be done on Monday a.m. and that John Quatermass has to approve final work.
 - Food at Bremerton – Ken Jones reported that concessionaire will sell espresso coffee. Lunch will consist of Chicago-style hot dogs. After the race, chili will be provided for workers.
 - Barrier painting – Bob Grass will bring the sprayer but will need paint. Bob will be at the track on Friday after 12. Ken Jones will have the fork lift there by then.
4. Track Trials report:
 - Mark McCloskey asked if the paddock would be paved for the Double National.
5. Double National event:
 - Registration – Sherri Masterson said that workers who plan to stay overnight at the track will need a pass but will not pay for it. Drivers who leave tow rig & race car in the paddock will pay \$10 for the weekend. Unknown if they will pay extra for an additional motor home.
 - Driver meeting letter – Bob Grass (Chief Steward) will write this.
 - Stewards feed – Bob Grass and Jay Bratton will arrange this steak feed.
6. Bremerton Motorsports Park:
 - Sherri Masterson reported that barriers must be painted. Also no campfires are allowed on site.
7. Website: Sherri reported that this is now okay.
8. July Double Regional: Sherri Masterson asked if we could consider a luau for the Saturday night food. Jay Bratton suggested that we might allocate \$500 for that. Sherri will investigate the cost of food for that menu.

Next Race Committee meeting will be held at Andy's Diner on Monday, May 21. This is one week earlier than the regular meeting night since the Double National will fall on the fourth Monday in May.
