

2011 Northwest Region-Only Rules

CR –Club Rabbit

General Intent: Allows Rabbits conforming to the specifications of International Conference of Sports Car Clubs (ICSCC) aka “Conference” to compete in a Northwest Region class. 2011 Northwest Region Club Rabbit rules are derived directly from the ICSCC source located at: <http://www.icsc.com/> under Technical References section.

All CR classed cars must have an ICSCC logbook and have entered an ICSCC race within the last 12 months (a one-race waiver will be allowed). For this regional only class that is not referenced in the GCR, cars shall meet fuel specifications as defined in GCR 9.3.26 for SS, T and IT classifications:

All cars entering SCCA events under CR class rules shall meet 2011 SCCA GCR safety standards. Note: ICSCC rules permit grandfathering of older cars in some cases with regard to newer safety regulations. This grandfathering is expressly ***NOT*** permitted in SCCA Club Racing unless the car is eligible for Vintage, in which case the car is only eligible for Vintage unless updated to current safety standards.
