come Corteco into the Indy Racing League and hope that our relationship is beneficial for everyone."

Corteco is a manufacturer of automotive aftermarket sealing and vibration control products and was established as the aftermarket business arm of Freudenberg-NOK (which does not have any ties to Kelley Racing general manager Jim Freudenberg).

"Corteco is thrilled to be the primary sponsor of Kelley Racing with one of the true icons of motorsports behind the wheel," said Greg Gyllstrom, president & CEO of Corteco. "We will have a comprehensive program revolving around the sponsorship. This sponsorship will play a major role in helping us establish a strong Corteco brand in the aftermarket."

Unser is no stranger to last-minute deals that allow him to race. The 2000 season nearly dawned without him but Rick Galles was able to put together a deal at the last minute with Starz/Super Pak to allow the team to run. Unser has been working for the last three months to put a deal together after Galles said that he could not fund an entry in the 2002 IRL campaign. Kelley Racing snared the 39-year-old driver Thursday, replacing 1999 IRL champion Ray two days after Ray was released from his ride, the team citing Ray's failure to bring sponsorship to the program. "The Unser name has been synonymous with racing for a long time," Kelley said, "but Al Jr.'s accomplishments stand alone, and we're proud to have him aboard."

## SCCA® MEMBERSHIP REACHES ALL-TIME HIGH

CENTENNIAL, Colo. (February 05, 2002) - As of January 2002, The Sports Car Club of America, Inc. now boasts a membership totaling over 63,000. Officially at 63,368, the SCCA has attained the highest membership in its 58-year existence.

During the calendar year, the membership department processed over 44,000 membership renewals, over 17,000 new applications and collected \$1.9 million in National dues. In addition, these departments collected and distributed more than \$735,000 in Regional dues to the Club's 109 regions.

"The SCCA has experienced substantial growth over the past year due to the dedication of our membership and licensing divisions," said Steve Johnson, SCCA President and CEO. "The Club's future is bright and these numbers are very encouraging as we continue to move forward with increased participation and awareness. We hope to have 70,000 members by this time next year."

In the central licensing area, the number of competition license holders grew in all Club activities. The central licensing staff maintained records for over 100 license specialties, including 12,000 competition drivers and 8,800 licensed officials. The Club continues to have the most active worker base in motorsports world-wide.

The SCCA continues to groom top-notch, world-

class drivers and race officials in the most diverse racing organization in the world. As the SCCA steams into its 58th year of existence, over 63,000 members within 109 regions across the country compete in over 2000 sanctioned events per year.
