Ron Bauer staged the comeback of the weekend in C Street Prepared. Down almost 0.6 second after Saturday, Ron laid down a second run on Sunday that was 1.4 seconds faster than the day one leader's best effort. Ron's 2007 Mazda MX5 is proving to be a formidable weapon in the class.
