

Fordahl Motorsports Series winners named

Trophy winners for the 2009 Fordahl Motorsports Championship Series have been identified.

There were 17 class champions, plus 27 place winners. To be eligible, competitors must compete in a minimum of five events and be an annual member of SCCA before the fifth event. Place winners are determined based on the average number of entries in the class for the season: one place for each three entries (or fraction thereof).

Non-Stock 4 led the way with the most competitors (18.25) and trophies (seven). Following closely were Street Tire (16.75 and six) and Open PAX (13.88 and five).

Awards will be presented at the annual Coneheads Banquet, co-hosted by the Western Washington Sports Car Council. The banquet is in the planning stages and is scheduled for Jan. 23 at F.X. McRory's in Seattle. Look for a formal announcement soon on the NWR Web site.
